

Forest mat care instructions

Watering:

- Water forest mat generously with fresh water immediately after it has been installed. It is a good idea to water the mat daily for 2-3 weeks after it has been laid.
- It is recommended to water generously at the weekends if it is not possible during the week.
- Using a sprinkler is an easy way to make sure your new forest mat gets enough water. After watering, the ground underneath should also be clearly saturated with water, showing that forest mat has received enough moisture.
- Later, forest mat should be watered when necessary, according to the amount of rain and natural moisture available. Watering should be regular during the first summer, especially during drier periods. The root layer of the mat should remain damp throughout the whole first summer in your yard.
- If laid in the fall, forest mat should be watered throughout the following growing season (spring-summer).

Later use:

- If you notice grass or weeds and do not want them growing in your forest mat, it is best to remove them as soon as they appear.
- Walking on forest mat should be avoided, especially during the first year. Paths will form on forest mat if walked on often.
- In winter, avoid storing excess snow on top of forest mat.
- Forest mat does not need basic improvements, just let it live its own life in the yard!
- Your forest mat will also produce berries if pollinators such as insects inhabit your yard.

Worth noting:

- Forest mat may turn brown immediately after being laid but it will recover during the following growing season.
